And, in another in a long line of flawed management decisions, GE recently announced a plan to split the company into three. It appears that the new plan is being done with approval of GE's Board of Directors to appease the greed of Trian, a hedge fund that holds less than 5 percent of the company shares.

GE took in more than \$4 billion in taxpayer-funded United States defense work in 2021.
