GE was founded in 1892 with plants in Lynn, Mass. and Schenectady, NY. From the beginning, our taxpayers and workers supported and subsidized GE to become the world's top energy corporation. Its aviation and power generation divisions remain GE's most profitable.

Yet for decades GE has sold off, outsourced and offshored our jobs and polluted our environment. GE focused on financial engineering when the world needed electrical engineering. Yet, in the past twenty years GE's stock price has plunged to a level less than a quarter of what it was even as GE scientists and engineers continue their world-leading research.

Today we ask, will GE Build Back Better or continue to destroy good jobs?

GE researchers in Schenectady develop cutting edge renewable energy systems. GE's destruction of our industrial base jeopardizes our jobs, our environment, and our national security as elongated supply chains are inherently susceptible to disruption and more vulnerable to cyber sabotage.

In Massachusetts, where GE manufactures military and civilian aircraft engines, employment keeps falling and key components are outsourced, including to countries that are in strategic competition with the U.S. GE's destruction of our industrial base jeopardizes our jobs, our environment and our national security.

Now we have the chance, as President Biden says, to truly Build Back Better and create millions of U.S. jobs—to reach President Biden's goal to make America a manufacturing leader in energy and transportation technologies. Will GE be part of the solution or part of the problem?

It is time for GE to stop the financial games and create manufacturing jobs in Schenectady, Lynn and across this country, shorten supply chains, combat climate change and build an improved economy for our communities and our country.
